

DEPART FROM PHILADELPHIA

Thursday, June 19, 2025

Gather at Philadelphia International Airport. Check in for flight to Heathrow. **Meals:** Dinner, breakfast and entertainment provided by the airline in flight

HEATHROW / GLASGOW, SCOTLAND

Friday, June 20, 2025

Friday morning we land at London-Heathrow, and have a short connecting flight to Glasgow International Airport. We transfer to the city center, leave our luggage at the hotel, and have free time to explore and have lunch in our small groups. **Guided Walking Tour** of **Glasgow**. In the late afternoon we return to the hotel, check in and have dinner together. Welcome to Scotland!

EXCURSION TO STIRLING CASTLE / FALKIRK WHEEL

Saturday, June 21, 2025

After breakfast, load the motorcoach and depart for **Stirling Castle** (the entrance is included as part of our Scottish Explorers Pass). We present a mid-morning **Informal Concert** (Royal Chapel tbc). Free time for an independent lunch at the castle canteen, then depart for the **Falkirk Wheel**. The Falkirk Wheel was a Millenium Project, reconnecting the two main canals of Scotland, which differ in height by more than 100 ft. Google it! We will take a voyage in the wheel, experiencing the Archimedes Principle for ourselves. Return to Glasgow, with the evening free and dinner independent.

WELLINGTON CHURCH / OBAN

Sunday, June 22, 2025

This morning we check out of the hotel, load the luggage on the motorcoach and transfer to the **Wellington Church**, an historic local parish with a strong church music tradition. We have a **Service Participation** (tbc) this morning, then depart for the Western port city of Oban. En route we stop in **Inverary**, for an independent lunch. Continue to Oban, and check into the hotel this evening, with dinner provided. **Meals:** Breakfast and Dinner provided

EXCURSION TO IONA ISLAND

Monday, June 23, 2025

We collect our sack lunches from the hotel desk after an early breakfast, walking to the ferry terminal for our early morning ferry to the **Isle of Mull**. Next we transfer to the **Isle of Iona**, where we visit **Iona Abbey** (entrance included as part of the Explorer's Pass). We have a mid-afternoon **Informal Concert** (Iona Abbey tbc), then we return by bus and ferry to Oban. Dinner independent in Oban. **Meals:** Breakfast provided

EXCURSION TO STAFFA ISLAND/EDINBURGH

Tuesday, June 24, 2025

We check out of our rooms and leave our luggage with the hotel porters. We collect our sack lunches from the hotel desk after an early breakfast, walking to the ferry terminal for our early morning ferry to the **Isle of Mull**. Here we board a waiting motorcoach to bring us to the opposite side of the island, where a private boat takes us to **Staffa Island**. Staffa is a basaltic formation (very interesting – Google it!). June is puffin season on Staffa, so we should have the chance to view these darling migratory birds chirp and peck, then fly back out to sea. Return to Oban in the afternoon. We load the luggage and depart. Dinner provided en route. **Meals:** Breakfast and Dinner provided

EDINBURGH, SCOTLAND

Wednesday, June 25, 2025

After breakfast we walk to **St. Giles, Cathedral** where we have an **Acoustical Rehearsal** prior to our **Lunchtime Concert** in St. Giles Cathedral (tbc). Free time for lunch in our small groups. Mid-afternoon we walk up the Royal Mile to **Edinburgh Castle** (entrance included with the Explorer's Pass). Evening free and dinner independent. This is still one of the longest days of the year, so it is light until nearly 10:00pm. One Edinburgh tradition is to hike up to **Arthur's Seat**, which gives a beautiful view of the sunset (good walking/hiking shoes encouraged).

EDINBURGH, SCOTLAND

Thursday, June 26, 2025

This morning we have a **Guided Walking Tour** of Edinburgh, and we finish before lunch. and the remainder of the morning and afternoon are free for you to explore Edinburgh, and you can still put your Explorer's Pass to good use. Also, the National Gallery does not have a set entrance fee, but a suggested donation. This evening we have our **Farewell Banquet**, with great food, toasts, and a celebration of a great 10 days together! Late return to the hotel.

FLYING HOME / HIGHLAND EXTENSION TOUR

Friday, June 27, 2025

Note: Pending interest, a 3-night extension tour will be planned for the Scottish Highlands, staying near Inverness, and also including the Isle of Skye and the Glencoe Valley.
